The Hale County School District/Board of Education is seeking bids for student chromebook devices, Google Chrome Management licenses, and an extended device warranty with the most responsive bidder offering a proposal deemed the most acceptable and advantageous to the Hale County School District.

	It is the responsibility of the vendor to check the website for any changes to the quote request periodically and before submitting a bid.		
D.	Sealed bids must be submitted to Hale County Board of Education, ATTN: Dianne Colburn, 1115 Powers Street, Greensboro, AL 36744 prior to the bid opening scheduled for Wednesday, March 27, 2024 at 2:00 p.m. CST. The sealed bids must include two (2) printed copies and one (1) PDF file on a USB flash drive. Any late bids will not be opened or considered. No faxed or electronic bids will be accepted.		
	Failure to provide the information requested in this RFP in the requested format is reason for disqualification, without consideration.		
E.	All bidders must complete and submit the Bid Response Form included with this document, as a minimum, for submitting their bid pricing and company information, as well as all other requested documentation.		
	The vendor's quote may include additional quote pages in the vendor's preferred format. However, all pricing must be entered in the Bid Response Form, as a minimum, to enable the district to compare pricing from all bidders using the same form. Reference statements, such as "See Page XX," "Refer to Page XX," etc. must not be entered in the Bid Response Form.		
F.	It is the bidder's responsibility to comply with all local, state and federal laws applicable within the context of this bid.		
G.	Hale County School District is exempt from all sales and use taxes under the provisions of Title 40, Chapter 23, Section 4 (15), Code of Alabama, 1975.		
H.	Bid price is to be all-inclusive (including fees, licenses, delivery charges, etc.) with no allowable additional costs to Hale County School District. Prices shall be good for the length of this contract. The effective dates of the contract shall be April 5, 2024 through July 31, 2024.		

I.	The entire order will be made in one single purchase, with the option for the district to purchase additional devices at a later date, if applicable. All purchased equipment will be shipped to one (1) location at the following address: Hale County Board of Education ATTN: Dianne Colburn 1115 Powers Street Greensboro, AL 36744 The district does not have a loading dock or forklift on hand to unload pallets from the delivery
	truck. Inside delivery is required.
J.	Hale County School District will review all proposals utilizing guidelines outlined by the Alabama State Bid Law.
K.	The final awarding of this bid will be made by the Hale County Board of Education based on a recommendation from the superintendent. Hale County Board of Education reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, waive any technicalities, and award all or part of the contract in a manner that is in the best interest of Hale County School District.
L.	Hale County School District reserves the right to cancel the contract with the vendor for nonperformance at any time during the contract period. Nonperformance includes, but is not limited to, failure to supply good quality products and services, failure to provide products and services for the full term of the contract, poor billing and customer service services, and failure to maintain status as an authorized representative of the products and services.
M. Other factors of consideration may be but are not limited to quality of proposed product and services, prior experience and company qualifications, and flexibility of delivery times and arrangements. Hale County School District does not guarantee award of a contract and reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

This bid will NOT be awarded on an item-by-item basis.
