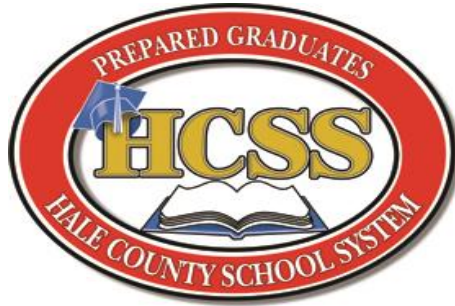

On October 16, 2020, the first day of the second nine weeks, the number of traditional students in the Hale County School System will increase by 469 students. To ensure a smooth transition for all areas in our system, we will adhere to the following schedule:

Friday, October 16, 2020 - Independent Work Day - This will be an e-learning day and will be the last day for students to complete and turn in any missing assignments from the first nine weeks.

Monday, October 19, 2020 - Staggered Day with traditional students with the last name A-M will attend school.

Tuesday, October 20, 2020 - Staggered Day with traditional students with the last name N-Z attend school.

The purpose of staggered days is to allow teachers, CNP staff, and transportation to adjust to the increase in numbers.

Wednesday, October 21, 2020- Remote/E-learning Day- students will have assignments to complete.

Thursday, October 22, 2020, and Friday, October 23, 2020- All traditional students will attend school.

Monday, October 26, 2020 - December 18, 2020- All traditional students will follow the current face to face schedule on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays with a Remote/ E-learning Day on Wednesdays.

Please note that this can change due to an increase of COVID-19 cases in the county. If this happens, we will provide information as soon as possible.
